**DESIGNATING JUNE 15, 2019,
COOK COUNTY TOWNSHIP DAY IN NILES TOWNSHIP**

The Niles Township Board of Trustees does hereby find as follows:

WHEREAS, Township government is the oldest existing unit of government in the United States, established in 1636 in Providence, Rhode Island and established in Niles Township in 1850; and

WHEREAS, 85 of Illinois' 102 counties operate under the Township form of Government and the 1,431 Townships serve more than 8 million citizens; and

WHEREAS, Niles Township serves over 104,863 citizens in the communities of Skokie, Lincolnwood, Golf, including portions of Morton Grove, Niles, and Glenview, with no unincorporated areas; and


