**RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES
BETWEEN NILES TOWNSHIP AND MICHAEL ISAACS**

WHEREAS, Niles Township, Cook County, State of Illinois (the “Township”) is a duly organized and existing township and a unit of local government organized under the laws of the State of Illinois and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Township Code, 60 ILCS 1/1-1, *et. seq.*, and all laws amendatory thereto; and

WHEREAS, Section 85-10 of the Township Code (60 ILCS 1/85-10(d)) authorizes the Township to enter into contracts or agreements necessary to exercise the Township’s powers;

WHEREAS, the Township Board is authorized to enter into contracts to hire independent contractors to provide specific professional services for the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisor and Township Board of Trustees for Niles Township (the “Township Board”) have determined that it is in the best interests of the Township to enter into an Agreement for Professional Services with an independent contractor to provide particular services on certain terms as identified and described in “**Exhibit A**” (the “Agreement”).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Supervisor and Board of Trustees of Niles Township, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That all of the recitals and legislative findings contained in the preambles to this Resolution are true and correct and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2: The Township Board hereby approves this Resolution and the Agreement for Professional Services between Niles Township and Michael Isaacs, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as **Exhibit A**.

SECTION 3: The Supervisor is authorized to execute all documents on the Township’s behalf to finalize the above-referenced Agreement. The Supervisor is authorized to approve any modifications to correct any scrivener errors or any other such technical changes to the Agreement

so long as the substantive provisions remain as approved herein.

SECTION 4. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Resolution.

SECTION 5: All resolutions, motions, or orders in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 6: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage provided by law.



EXHIBIT A

Agreement for Professional Services between Niles Township and Michael Isaacs

Agreement for Professional Services between Niles Township and Michael Isaacs

This Agreement is made and entered into this 1st day of April 2023, between the Township of Niles and Michael Isaacs.

Recitals

WHEREAS, the Township of Niles (hereinafter the “Township”) is a duly organized and existing township and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and operating under the provisions of the Illinois Township Code, 60 ILCS 1/1-1 *et. seq.*, and all amendments made thereto; and

WHEREAS, Michael Isaacs (hereinafter “Independent Contractor”) is a professional with his principal place of business at 6908 N Oakley #1, Chicago, Illinois 60645, and has complied with all Federal, State, and local laws regarding permits, licenses, reporting, tax and other legal requirements that may be necessary to carry out his obligations under this Agreement.; and

WHEREAS, the Township seeks to engage Independent Contractor for professional services as specified and governed herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above recitals and mutual promises and conditions contained in this Agreement, the sufficiency of which the parties heretofore stipulate, it is hereby agreed:

Section 1: Recitals. The Recitals stated above are incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: Scope of Work. Independent Contractor’s scope of work shall be as follows:

A. Independent Contractor shall be responsible for the creation and dissemination of Township content and events, including but not limited to: the development of the Township Newsletter, all social media postings, targeted electronic communications, special event coordination, public relations, and media relations.

B. Township shall at all times remain the owner of Township data and content as used or supplied to Independent Contractor. Independent Contractor shall provide all necessary equipment, materials, and supplies to complete the scope of work.

C. Independent Contractor shall diligently perform the scope of work to the best of his talents, skills, and expertise. Independent Contractor shall respond to all requests of the Township in an expedient manner. The Township reserves the right to inspect, stop or alter the work of Independent Contractor to assure its conformity with this Agreement. Any advice given to an Independent Contractor regarding the Scope of Work shall be considered a suggestion only, not an instruction. Independent Contractor agrees to work with Township to the mutual benefit of both parties and collaborate on best ways to accomplish assignments.

D. Independent Contractor shall keep books and records detailing his professional services on behalf of the Township, which the Township shall have the right to inspect.

Section 3: Compensation. Independent Contractor shall be entitled to compensation as follows:

A. The Township shall pay Independent Contractor compensation at a rate of \$3,958.39 per month as and for all work conducted by the Independent Contractor for the Township pursuant to this Agreement. The Township may reimburse Independent Contractor for additional, third-party fees or expenditures only with the prior written consent of the Township.

B. Independent Contractor shall be responsible for the payment of all taxes required by law and hereby promises to indemnify the Township for any damages or expenses, including attorneys' fees and expenses, incurred by the Township as a result of Independent Contractor's failure to make such required payments.

Section 4: Status as Independent Contractor. Independent Contractor shall serve the Township as an "at will" contractor, serving at the pleasure and direction of the Township Board. This Agreement shall not be construed to create a partnership, joint venture, employer-employee relationship, or agent-principal relationship between the parties for any purpose. Independent Contractor is not an agent of the Township and has no authority to bind the Township in any manner unless expressly authorized in writing. Independent Contractor hereby waives and foregoes any benefits given by the Township to its regular employees including but not limited to, health benefits, vacation, and sick leave benefits.

Independent Contractor remains a separate entity free to conduct similar tasks or activities for other clients, provided no conflict of interest exists. Independent Contractor shall be responsible to the Township Supervisor, but Independent Contractor will not be required to follow or establish a regular or daily work schedule. Independent Contractor will collaborate with the Township Supervisor about how best to cover special or specific-dated events.

Section 5: Term. This Agreement shall commence on the effective date stated above and shall continue for a period of one (1) year. This Agreement may be terminated early upon thirty (30) days written notice by either Party, with or without cause, or immediately upon written mutual consent of the Parties. Upon termination of this Agreement, each party shall immediately deliver to the other party all property, in physical or electronic form, in its possession or under its care and control, and shall provide all access codes, password information, and access instructions as needed.

Section 6: Insurance and Licensure. Independent Contractor shall maintain all insurance policies as required to perform under the Agreement. This includes but is not limited to professional liability insurance, if applicable. Only if applicable, the Independent Contractor will provide a copy of his Certificate of Insurance to the Township. Independent Contractor shall maintain all licenses, certificates, and permits required to perform his obligations under this Agreement in good standing and shall provide copies of said licenses, certificates, and permits upon request of the Township.

Section 7: Confidentiality of Information. Independent Contractor may unavoidably learn of confidential communications or documents during his scope of work. Independent Contractor shall not duplicate or disclose any communication or documents obtained by virtue of his scope of work under this Agreement to any third-party.

Section 8: Compliance. Independent Contractor shall comply with all applicable rules and regulations of the Township and all applicable federal, state, and local laws, statutes, ordinances, orders, codes, rules, and regulations relating to his obligations under this Agreement.

Section 9: Indemnification. Independent Contractor shall defend, indemnify, hold harmless, and insure the Township from any and all damages expenses, or liability resulting from or arising out of

any negligence or misconduct on the part of Independent Contractor or from any breach or default of this Agreement which is caused or occasioned by the acts of Independent Contractor.

Section 10: Assignment. This Agreement is personal in character and shall not be assigned, transferred, or delegated by Independent Contractor to any other party with the express written consent of the Township Board.

Section 11: Governing Law. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois. Any action relating to or arising out of this Agreement shall be initiated in the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois. The prevailing party of any such action shall be entitled to all fees, costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees incurred.

Section 12. Entire Agreement; Amendments. This Agreement memorializes the entire understanding between the parties with respect to the subject matter herein and supersedes all prior agreements and understandings. Any amendments made to this Agreement must be in writing, approved by the Corporate Authorities of the Township, and signed by each party.

Section 13. Severability. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the remaining portions of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and construed so as to best effectuate the intent and mutual understandings of the Parties.


Section 14. Signatures. The Parties to this Agreement have read the foregoing in its entirety and fully understand and agree to each and every provision contained herein.


